I checked the air filter. I fiddled with this and I fiddled with that. I drove to the auto-parts store and purchased some carburetor-cleaner spray. The engine started but again ran for a few seconds. I drove back to the auto-parts store and bought some fuel stabilizer. Back home, I siphoned the gas out of the tank and tried fresh gas with the stabilizer. No success. I went on the internet and reviewed how to do a thorough cleaning/rebuild of the carburetor.

To make a long story short (my sons would say, "Too late!"), I finally disconnected the fuel line and allowed some fuel to drain into my little pan. Whoa! Black grit! Lots of dirt in the fuel line!

Guess what? After draining the dirty gas, the engine started easily and ran problem-free for the entire job.

What's my point? It's that sometimes I forget to START WITH THE BASICS. When putting the washer away, 18 months earlier, I had run the fuel tank "dry," which invited the dirt from the very bottom of the tank to be sucked into the line. DUH! Checking that fuel line was a BASIC of the first order!

As we approach THANKSGIVING Day, let me go back to an important basic... gratitude.

STRETCH YOUR GIFT


One Day ONLY... Your gift on FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 20, will be forwarded to ALM... with INCREASE!

The instructions are pretty simple:

- 1. On Friday, November 22 (midnight to midnight), go to the website *ExtraGive.org.*
- 2. Click in the SEARCH field (top right, by the symbol of a magnifying glass). Search for Abundant Living Ministries.
- 3. Submit your gift by credit card. An email receipt, for tax purposes, will be sent to you by the ExtraGive program.
- 4. That's it! ExtraGive will forward your contribution, PLUS the proportionate amount from the Stretch Pool, to ALM.
