Many years ago, friends Bruce and Ruthie shared, with us, a story they had told their children to illustrate the importance of staying as far away from Satan's traps as possible...

Billy didn't wade into the puddle. He simply walked around the outer edge a few times.

Suddenly, the neighbor's big, friendly dog appeared out of nowhere and came bounding toward Billy. Before he realized what was happening, the huge dog splashed right through the puddle and then jumped up on Billy's chest, planting his muddy paws on Billy's clean shirt. After sliding his feet down the front of Billy's pants, he shook himself violently to get the muddy water off his fur, spritzing Billy from head to toe.

Ending the story, Bruce asked his children, "Did Billy do anything wrong? Did he disobey his mother?"
