Noteworthy is that the beliefs and values they declared in the first two paragraphs remain the heartfelt beliefs and values even today, here at ALM.

Yes, He is still able to do exceeding abundantly more than we can ask or even think! (Ephesians 3:20) HE CAME THAT WE MIGHT HAVE LIFE AND MIGHT HAVE IT MORE ABUNDANTLY! (John 10:10)

I found an additional item of interest in a newsletter from that first year, May of 1979. Here again we rejoice in saying that this remains an accurate description TODAY of what we do here at ALM.

"A psychologist recently asked us to explain to him the counseling methods which we use here. We explained that our method is very simple... the person relates their problem to us and then we seek to discover Biblical principles which apply in the solution of that problem. And we pray, asking for God's help in solving the problem. We know that God can make a way when, to us, there seems no answer. With Him, nothing is impossible!"

Home-made Ministry

With holidays approaching, many families are thinking about gatherings in their homes. For some this produces excited anticipation. For others, entertaining guests is a dreaded ordeal. Keep in mind that hospitality isn't about showing off your home, culinary skills, or decorating ability. It is about making your home a ministry center!



View hospitality through God's eyes. We're instructed in Romans 12:13 to, "Practice hospitality." 1 Peter 4:9 says, "Offer hospitality to

one another without grumbling."



Keep things simple. Do as much meal prep ahead of time as possible, refrigerating or freezing until needed. Let your spouse and

children know how they can help. Don't feel obligated to always serve a full meal... a simple dessert with a cup of coffee can set a warm, inviting atmosphere.



Welcome spur-of-the-moment opportunities. Well-planned special events are lovely, but sometimes it is the unplanned get-together

that turns out to be the most rewarding. Invite a neighbor for a dish of ice cream. Ask a young family back to your house for a light lunch after a Sunday service. Often these times are the start of long-lasting friendships.



Include the whole family, including the children in planning, prep, cleanup and conversation. But don't let the children steal the entire

focus of attention. Teach your children to ask good questions, as they invite guests to share about their lives.





Break out table games, tell jokes. And laugh a lot... Laughing together promotes closeness and is often an instant conversation booster.



Share Jesus' love. Pray before the meal and include a blessing over each guest. Or, what about this idea? When setting the table, place

one brightly-colored plate. Once seated, invite all guests to say something encouraging or affirming to the person who received that plate.



Utilize other settings. Hospitality can be practiced anywhere... going to a restaurant, taking someone shopping, doing a weekend outing

Any of these can provide wonderful opportunities to share God's love.



Pray about the guest list. Don't always socialize with only your best friends. The "unlikely"

guest Jesus brings your way, may turn out to be a huge blessing!
